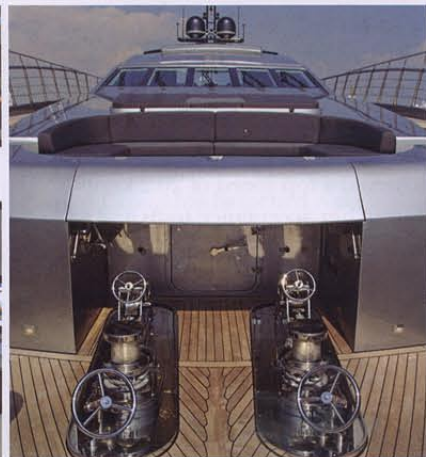

Bilgin Yachts' Noor

Turkish shipyard, Bilgin Yachts delivered 37-metre *Noor* to her owner in mid April. The yacht's external lines have been designed by the shipyard's engineering and design office, following the owner's ideas. The interior and styling are the work of Italian Hot Lab yacht & design studio, which created a warm minimal design with clear modern elements. On the main deck there is a wide salon made of two parts: a convivial area and a dining area. Going ahead you reach a spectacular staircase connecting the lower and the upper deck. On the left side there is the galley, while after the corridor there is the owner's suite with relaxation area. The lower deck is for the guests: astern there are two double guest cabins, afore one VIP cabin. On the upper deck the salon is a wide warm area, with a modern touch thanks to a completely open dining area directly facing the outside lounge

area. On the fly bridge, loose modern furniture comfortably seats more than eight people, a custom made bar faces aft and afore a huge sofa and sunbeds complete the outfitting.

Benetti's 62-metre *Bistango* was launched mere days before her debut at The Genoa Boat Show at the beginning of May. Main features on board include an elevator, helipad,

Turkish bath on the sundeck and a baby grand piano. Her lavish interior reflects the taste of her owner and features very lush and warm design enhanced by layers of gold leaf with African undertones.

Bistango accommodates 12 guests in six cabins and has a total of 14 crew members. Following her launch, she is now available for charter in the Mediterranean this summer through Burgess Yachts.
