Look out for: The use of glass throughout, from the extensive glazing in the sides of the main deck, to the panes of glass in the ceiling, and the big windows in the main-deck master. There's even moulded glass in the handtop.

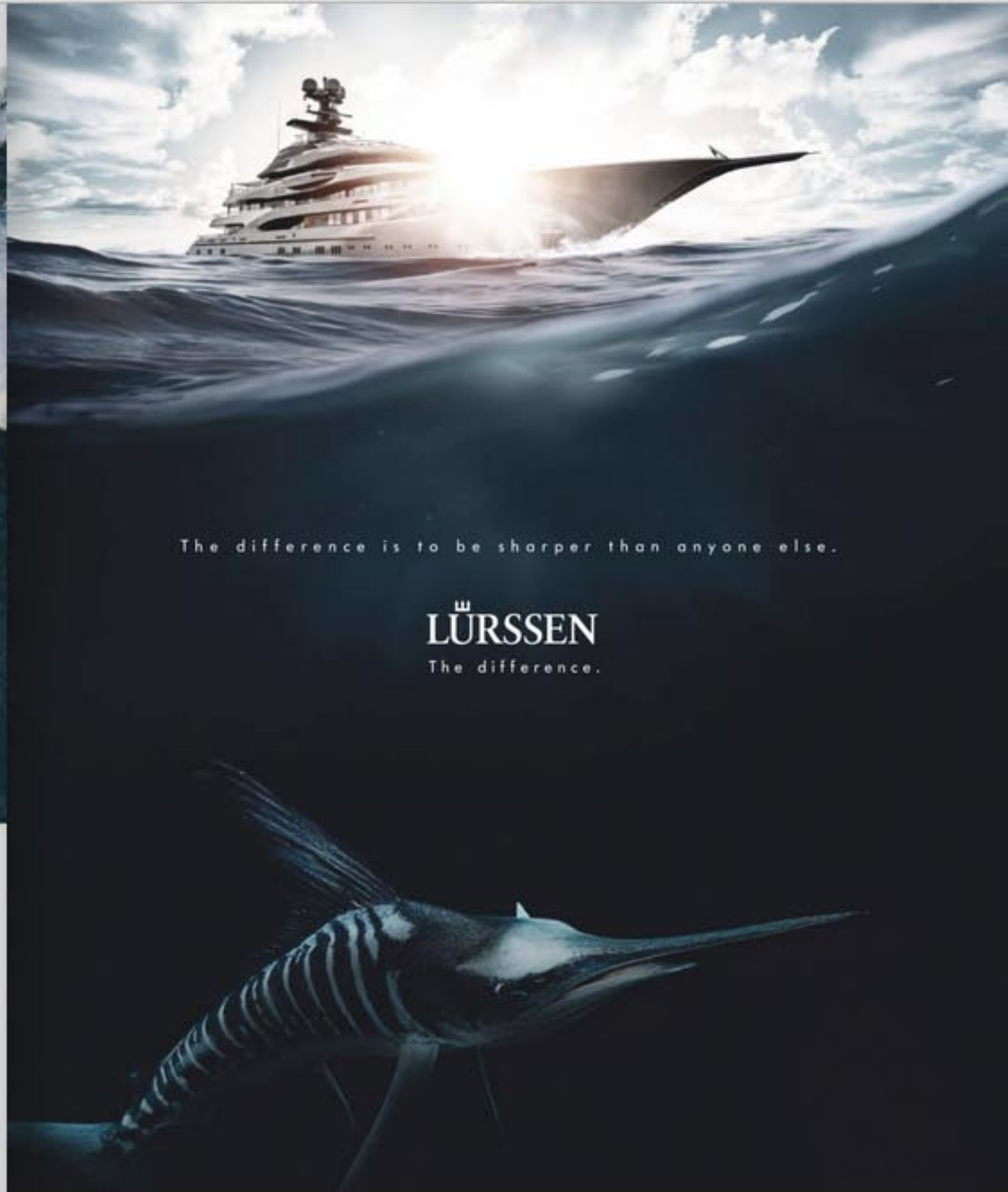
