Steeling the show

Arcadia Yachts unleashed its first steel concepts at the Cannes Yachting Festival.

rcadia Yachts is making an entry into the world of steel-hulled vessels with its new FOR.TH (Forward Thinking) range. The yard is collaborating with Hot Lab Studio on the project and remains open to foreign partnerships to collaborate on the first unit's engineering and production.

The first model of the Gamma FOR.TH will be 47 metres long, with a maximum beam of nine metres. Continuing its signature look, Arcadia has included the use of large glass surfaces and open transoms on both the main and upper decks.

The conventional linear design is contrasted with an almost completely glass prism, of architectural inspiration, providing the interiors with a significant amount of natural light.

Usable interior space is concentrated just forward of amidships to allow for ample sunlit and shaded areas on the aft decks.

The exterior design solutions reflect the yard's focus on conviviality. Design

philosophy for the proposed interiors is based on a refined and contemporary open floorplan inspired by modern real estate designs. The proposed displacement is just under 500 gross tonnes.

The 78-square-metre sundeck can include a transparent Jacuzzi surrounded by a spacious, C-shaped sunbathing area.

There is a bar on the 43-squaremetre upper deck, shielded by a laminated structure that lets the sun filter through when desired. arcadiayachts.it

The yacht's five decks house a six-metre pool and spa area featuring a massage room, sauna and Jacuzzi, as well as a party space, extensive sunbathing and relaxing areas and a sports deck with a bar and sizeable TV screen.

A full-beam beach club with fold-down balconies on both sides cleverly connects directly to the swimming platform, which gives 180-degree access to the sea and features two grand staircases to the expansive main deck on either side. Two tenders, a waterski boat and a host of watertoys are hidden below the foredeck.

Internally, a cinema, a main saloon with 270-degree views and an office/conference room ensure the owner and guests are well looked after. The six or eight guest cabins are well appointed and lead through to an open-plan dining room, with an expandable table to seat up to 14 guests. A cinema/playroom as well as multiple exterior dining and bar areas underline the focus on leisure



and entertaiment.
