COMFORT MEETS CRUISING CAPABILITY

With its new 47MXP, Numarine introduces a flagship designed for long-range Mediterranean cruising, combining expanded onboard space, efficient performance, and refined design

Numarine's latest release, the 47MXP, builds on the proven XP series platform with increased volume, greater versatility, and notable enhancements geared toward long-range exploration. At 46.7 metres in length and with a gross tonnage of 498 GT, this steel-hulled yacht maintains the rugged explorer spirit while offering significantly improved onboard amenities.

The MXP - short for Mediterranean Explorer - reimagines the cruising lifestyle through expanded exterior decks and a reconfigured beach club. With two pools, one located aft and another at the bow, as well as balconies that open onto the sea, the design brings guests closer to the water without compromising the vessel's offshore capability.

The 47MXP shares its 9.25-metre beam with the 45XP,

but the added length creates room for up to six guest cabins and a generous owner's suite complete with private terrace. Hot Lab, part of the Viken Group, has been tasked with the interior, expected to reflect their hallmark balance of clean lines and warm finishes.

Powered by twin MAN 1,450 hp engines, the yacht offers a cruising speed of 12 knots and a transoceanic range of 6,000 nautical miles at 9 knots. The upper deck is optimized for storing tenders and toys, while the sundeck - fitted with a bar and multiple lounging areas - caters to open-air living.

Blending robust build quality with a layout suited to Mediterranean and remote cruising alike, the 47MXP positions itself as a serious contender in the explorer yacht category.
