Meanwhile, Hot Lab handled the interior design, which includes a floating staircase, sundeck skylight and statement chandelier in the main lobby, among other special features. 
# Set sail for Sri Lanka

#### The science of seafaring

Published in 1583, Nautical Works was an encyclopaedic marvel created for the royal patrons of French naval pilot Jacques Devaulx. The loose-bound pages brimmed with elaborate illuminations, oceanic maps and volvelles (wheel charts) – an early example of the paper analogue computer. This edition,

The first Atlantique 47 model has hit the water in Ancona, Italy. Built by Columbus Yachts, a brand of Palumbo Superyachts, Acqua Chiara has a taut, stern-focused exterior said to be inspired by sailing yachts. The main deck aft has several outdoor spaces to choose from, including a sheltered dining area, a pool lounge and a swim platform with a transformer that sits 50 centimetres above the water.
