"The owner of this yacht wanted it to feel natural, elegant and spontaneous. It had to have a 'grown-up' emphasis in certain areas, and a more playful and youthful spirit in others. We aimed to produce a design that was both recognisable and timeless.

"As always, when a family of individuals shares a brief, the biggest challenge is finding a solution that can rise above varying tastes, and is accepted by everyone. We collaborated closely with them, which naturally led to multiple revisions and many small changes. However, none of our initial concept was compromised.

"We almost never look at precise references from other projects, and rather than focusing on single elements, we tried to create an ensemble that felt just right together. The flooring, furniture, curtains and chairs blend seamlessly in a simple and immediate way, as if they were designed to coexist. The connection between the technical components and the stylistic ones - for example, the laminated glass doors with bronze mesh - serve as both an aesthetic feature and a wonderful example of functionality. When you manage to bring both beauty and practicality on board at once, that's when you feel fully satisfied."
