Technical launches

On the boat cranes this month...

1. MONDOMARINE M50 IPANEMA

Mondomarine's 50-meter Ipanema has been one of the most memorable launches of late, mainly due to her unmistakable deep red hull. Designed inside and out by the Milan based Hot Lab, the triple deck M50 features a sharply styled bow and steeply raked stern, giving her a sporty look while still following Mondomarine's traditional styling. Inside her light alloy hull and superstructure, 12 guests can be accommodated in four guest cabins with the Owner having a suite to himself.

2. BERING 80 VEDA

Veda, a 25-meter Bering 80 has been launched and takes her place as the flagship of the range. Veda is the fourth vessel in the Expedition Class, as well as the heaviest, tipping the scales at 209 imperial tons. With a beam of almost 8-meters, she is spacious

as well as tough, able to accommodate eight guests across her four staterooms.
