From Istanbul, where Turquoise Yachts shapes steel into dreams, Neptune emerges as a 60-metre vision sculpted with Hot Lab. A creation where engineering meets elegance, and every line reflects the future of a shipyard destined to redefine the seas.

Neptune: Grace forged for the Waves

Neptune is proof that two creative forces — the shipbuilding precision of Turquoise Yachts in Istanbul and the aesthetic vision of Hot Lab in Milan — can converge to give life to a 60-metre superyacht that embodies harmony between strength and beauty, function and wonder, sea and light.

Her silhouette stretches across 60.9 metres with a beam of 11.8 metres and a gross tonnage of 1,300 GT. Engineered on the proven 65-metre platform of Turquoise with Azure Naval Architects, Neptune is designed with a steel hull and aluminium superstructure, classed by Lloyd's Register. Propelled by twin Caterpillar 3512C engines for a top speed of around 16 knots, she is a vessel conceived for balance, resilience, and presence.

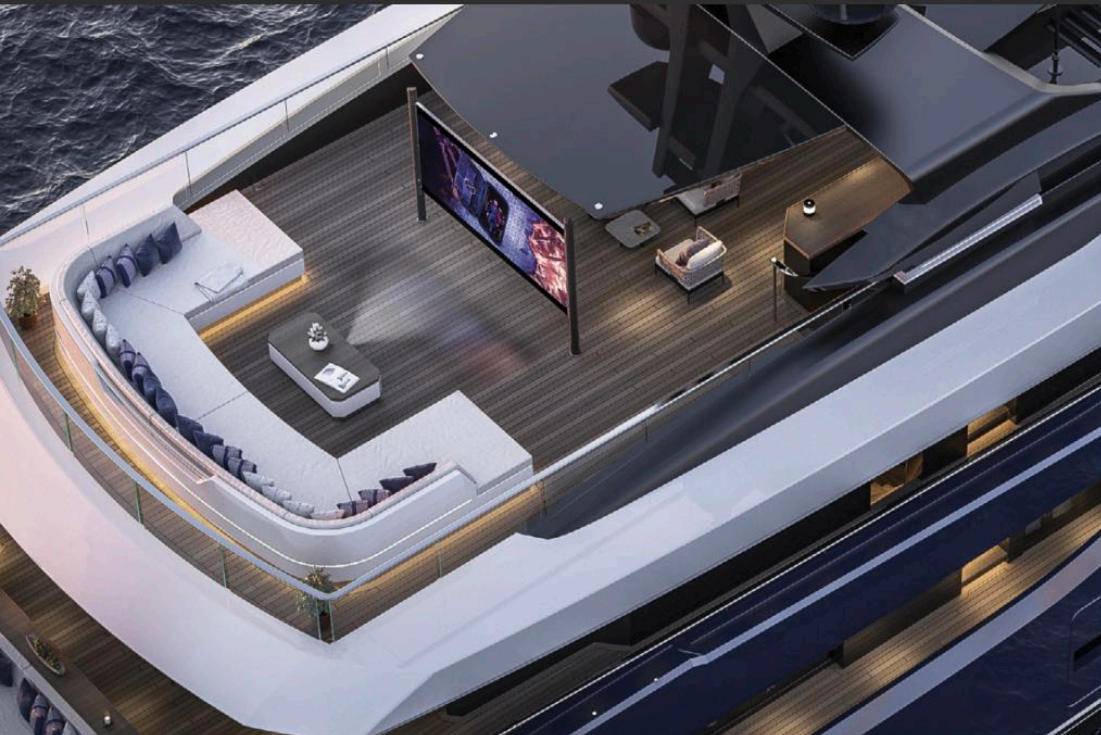
The design by Hot Lab sculpts Neptune as a fluid sculpture at sea: contours that flow like waves, proportions that breathe elegance, and vast bands of glass that dissolve barriers between interior and horizon. Every line draws the eye to movement, every window

frames infinity.

At the bow, the helipad emerges as both symbol and function — a portal for seamless arrivals, integrated into the profile so gracefully that it feels like an extension of her body. Its forward position preserves tranquillity across the decks, offering guests the serenity of uninterrupted horizons.

Aft, the scene shifts to the theatre of water. The main deck opens into a 6 x 3.5-metre swimming pool, flanked by terraces of light and air, conceived as both sanctuary and stage. Here Neptune reveals her dual nature: a place of calm reflection and a hub of conviviality, a pool that mirrors the sky while anchoring the rhythm of life on board. Expansive beach club platforms unfold like wings at sea level, connecting guests directly to the ocean. The lower deck houses a gym and club that transform wellness into a ritual framed by water, amplifying the idea of yachting as a lifestyle of fluid motion.

On the sun deck, a second pool with Jacuzzi rises above the sea, encircled

by lounges that invite both privacy and celebration. With every level, Neptune becomes a vertical journey, from ocean embrace to celestial terraces.

Antonio Romano, Partner and Business Director of Hot Lab, affirms: "At Hot Lab we are honoured to collaborate with Turquoise Yachts: their shipbuilding expertise, combined with our design vision, has made it possible to create a yacht concept that harmoniously merges elegance, innovation, and functionality, establishing a new benchmark in the 60m category."

And Enrico Lumini, Partner and Design Director of Hot Lab, adds:

"At the yacht's stern, guests will discover an impressive main deck pool area designed for relaxation and entertainment, thoughtfully positioned to maximize both sun exposure and stunning sea views, offering an idyllic spot to unwind or socialize."

Neptune's tenders and toys complete her promise of freedom: a 9.6-metre limo tender, a rescue boat, two jet skis. Guest accommodation is equally crafted: a master suite and multiple VIP cabins spread across the main and upper decks, creating a balance between intimacy and grandeur, served by

36 crew who orchestrate the voyage with precision.

More than a project, Neptune is a manifesto available for realization. She represents the shared philosophy of Turquoise Yachts and Hot Lab: innovation rooted in tradition, engineering elevated by design, beauty inseparable from function.

Neptune rises as an icon ready to take shape, a superyacht that speaks the language of tomorrow. A vessel sculpted for those who seek horizons where the sea itself becomes light, and every voyage transforms into art.
